Most of the units serve on Amtrak* intercity service throughout the United States, although several are in operation north of the border with Via Rail Canada.

The newly tooled WalthersMainline model captures all the details of its modern classic prototype, including accurate molded and separately applied parts and prototypical paint schemes. A top of the line WalthersProto drive, metal Proto MAX couplers, LED lighting, and metal wheels ensure a lifetime of reliable operation.


